HHJ MARTIN TODD

Dr Clark-Dowd qualified in 2010 as a Clinical Psychologist and has worked as an Expert Witness for the Courts for 11 years, providing evidence based, well-researched reports in proceedings. Dr Clark-Dowd provides psychological assessments to inform matters of risk, ability to parent, intellectual and personality factors contributing to understanding of behaviour and likelihood of change.

Dr Clark-Dowd will be discussing risk assessment measures and protective factors, along with the framework HCR-20.
